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Suicidal Students

Any student who indicates suicidal thoughts or tendencies in writing, verbally or action is to be taken to a pediatric emergency room crisis intervention worker by their parents. There they are to be evaluated. Medical clearance is to be given in writing in order for the student to return to school with a follow up appointment for counseling. If the parent fails to keep that appointment or successive appointments, DYFS is to be notified.

The school social worker/school nurse will follow up on this situation and will notify DYFS if the plan is not being maintained.
